Progress in Planning ECC 2009

Some of the Organising Committee and I visited Palma from the 25th through to the 30th of September to finalise the list of yachts, visit a number of proposed overnight stops we are considering in our route planning work, and visit locations proposed for some of the social events.



We were pleasantly received, guided and supported by our coordinating agent, Mallorcanautic, whom provided us with a fast boat and road transport between all the sites proposed and additional ones we wished to consider including. Mallorcanautic is owned and run by Victor and Macarena Llopis whom we found to be professional in their support, and we are confident they will help make ECC 2009 a great success.

We will provide more information regarding this visit in a subsequent bulletin, however in order for us all to get on with the very important business of chartering our yachts, that is all for now regarding the site visit.



List of Entrants

At the close of the entry process we have 61 entrants wishing to compete in 2009 for the ECC Trophy and the honour of being Commodore ECC 2010. We will also have eight Commodores competing for the Commodores Cup. The full list of eligible skippers accepted as entrants for the 2009 events are presented below in Table 1.



List of Yachts

Following ECC 2008 you may recall Arno (Hemm) issued a survey requesting feedback on lessons learned from this year's regatta. One result of this survey was the recommendation to widen the number of makes of yachts to obtain a younger fleet and hopefully more close competition.

Through the competitive bidding process to secure both an agent and a location for ECC 2009, we have brought together a wider variety than ECC has seen in a number of years, and the youngest fleet of those offered in the competitive bidding process. Yachts range in LOA

between 38' and 50.5'. It is my sincere hope that this years handicapped fleet will bring the close and exciting racing you are all seeking.

The final lists of yachts available for charter and acceptable for racing in 2009 are presented below in Table 2.

Time Correction Factors (TCFs) for each yacht in the fleet will be determined in the coming months with the assistance of a professional measurer and race

referee and will be reviewed prior to the ECC commencing for any changes to yacht rig measurements that might have occurred since our first TCF calculations.

Procedure for Selecting Yachts

This year as mentioned in an earlier bulletin we have decided to draw a 'lottery' to arrive at a selection order for skippers choosing their yachts. The results of the draw are as listed in Table 1.

Due to a Spanish bank holiday on Monday (13th Oct) Mallorcanautic will begin contacting you in the order on the list from **Tuesday the 14th of October**. They will be aiming to secure (ten) charter selections each day. Charter paperwork for each yacht will follow on accordingly.



We would ask that you each make your yacht selection as quickly as possible so we can all get through this selection and charter contracting process by about **October 25th**. Payments then need to be received by Mallorcanautic by the end of the month. If we miss this date substantially you risk losing your yacht. So I hope you will all

work with Mallorcanautic in the coming weeks to ensure we all get the best yacht we each can.

In the fleet list you will notice a sub-fleet of Bavaria 46's have been assembled, and reserved (as highlighted in yellow), for the scratch Commodores Cup race. Please appreciate it is necessary to have yachts as similar as possible in performance for this race as it is a scratch (no-handicap) race. We have sourced as many 46' yachts as possible so a lucky few will be able to compete head to head with the Commodores in the larger fleet of yachts in ECC races.

In order for you to be able to recognise skippers / your familiar friends on the water this year each skipper has been given a number that is tied to ECC yacht numbers from previous years (with some modified to suit). Once you have decided on your choice of 'Yacht ID' on the yacht list, MallorcaNautic will add your 'Skipper Number' on the entrants list to become your 'ECC 2009 yacht no.' for racing.

Insurance

I have had a number of emails and discussions with various people regarding how we can improve insurance agreements. In conjunction with the agent and input from Heinz Baedorff we have made available the most practicable insurance contracts we can for this 'flotilla' event.

I would encourage each skipper to review the relevant sections of their individual charter contracts carefully to understand how they work; what they cover, and what they are not able to reasonably cover.

Collision damage waivers are also available for those that prefer to utilise this option, amounts will vary depending on the yacht and range in cost from €100-200.
