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Dear ECC Sailors,

It is a pleasure for the organisation committee and me to welcome you in the community for the next ECC in 2010.



First of all I and my crew want to thank the 2009 OC, perfectly lead by Craig. They have managed a great event for us and all the other participants, on the water as well as on shore. I also want to convey my thanks to our Admiral John, who gave us the spirit to go for the win and who assists us with all the information we need to start the organisation. It was surprising for us to get so many spontaneous congratulations after the race – thanks to all of you. This was a good motivation for us to do our very best to supply you with another nice sailing week in 2010, not looking on the work that is in front of us.

1. Status of organisation

Preparation of the next event has started immediately after we came back from the prize giving party. First of all we established our key team for the organisation committee, consisting of

Next step was to collect all the necessary information that we need for the organisation. One of the first major challenges was to create the invitation to bid, which we have already sent out to several companies, beside one of them all are experienced coordinators of the ECC in the former years.

We are awaiting the proposals within the next days. Based on the proposals and the finally selected coordinator we will decide where we will be going to next year. The only thing I can say for the time being is that we will not be going to Mallorca / Menorca, but for sure, it will again be the Mediterranean Sea.

As period for the ECC 2010 we have selected the time from

08th May to 15th May 2010.

Beneath others this period was selected considering the Dutch May holidays that will end that



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weekend. Furthermore, at this time no major exhibition will be taking place.

I hope this selection will give all of you the opportunity to participate in the ECC.

We see no excuse not to join the ECC!

As we do not know where we will be going, the new logo is preliminary, but we want to give you an idea how it will look like (see the header).

2. Next Steps

We will start with the entry procedure soonest. The details will be announced in the next bulletin, but in principle it will follow the well known procedure. All eligible skippers will be invited and have to announce their intention to participate in the ECC, sending us a filled in registration form and submitting a first down-payment.

We are also establishing new email-addresses for the OC and will inform you as soon as they are ready. For the time being, please send any information for the OC to my email address.
