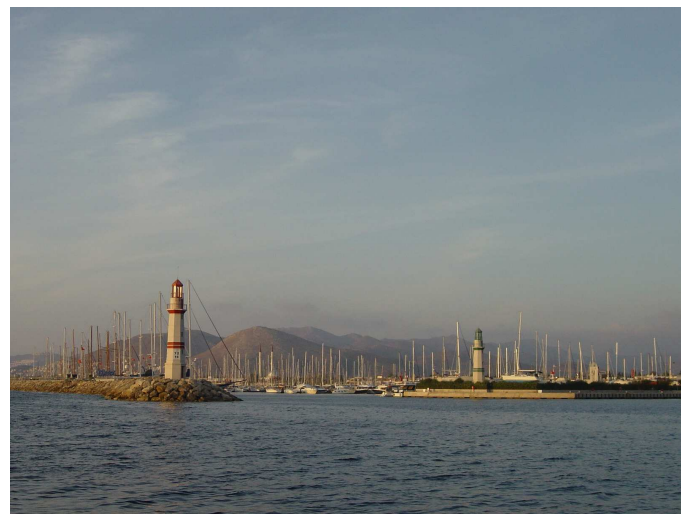
TURGUTREIS

At first sight Turgutreis, which is the 2nd largest city of Bodrum Peninsula (Bodrum is largest), has a paradise look. It is located between hills on a Toscanne look-alike area with olive trees and cypresses. From Turgutreis you can see the Greek islands Kos, Pserimos and Kalymnos.

Turgutreis has grown considerably from the small fishing village it once was. Hotels and holiday villages spread across the nearby slopes, stretching the village into a sizeable resort town. Much of this part of the coast is now a continuous carpet of concrete, impossible to tell where the original villages begin and end.

For all that, Turgutreis is a working town, with an excellent market bringing products in from surrounding countryside.

Now we have closed the boat selection procedure we can close the completed boat list. You can find skipper, represented company, boat type and boat number on the list. Please be aware that your boat number is different from the entry list number. We will use your boat number for all further registrations.

All of you have received a charter contract from Sasha of Adriatic Holidays together with an invoice for 50 % of the charter fee. Most of you have already signed the contract and paid the deposit charter fee. For those who have not yet fulfilled their commitments, please arrange without any delay. Please be informed that the ECC organization paid a bail for reservation of the boats and that we need contracts signed and paid to balance.

We like to make one remark to skippers who transferred the net amount only and failed to pay bank transfer fee as presented on the invoice. We expect you to balance this bank cost with your payment in March 2008.

Crewlists

We still don't have all crew lists yet. Please try to get your crew together and check their passport numbers, tel. nos, shirt sizes, hand sizes, etc.

Also send together with the crew list your crew photo. This can be a separate photo of the crewmembers (please with names) or a photo all together.
